Moose

Definition

- A large long-headed mammal, of the deer family.



Origin

- 1595-1605
- Native North American Algonquian.



More on Moose...

- The word “Moose” come from an Algonquian word Moosu meaning “he strips off”.
- The plural of Moose is still Moose.

Definition

- Any of several ruminants of the family Cervidae.

- Before 900.
- Middle English.



More on deer...
