- ◉ Ranked: 11<sup>th</sup> in the United States

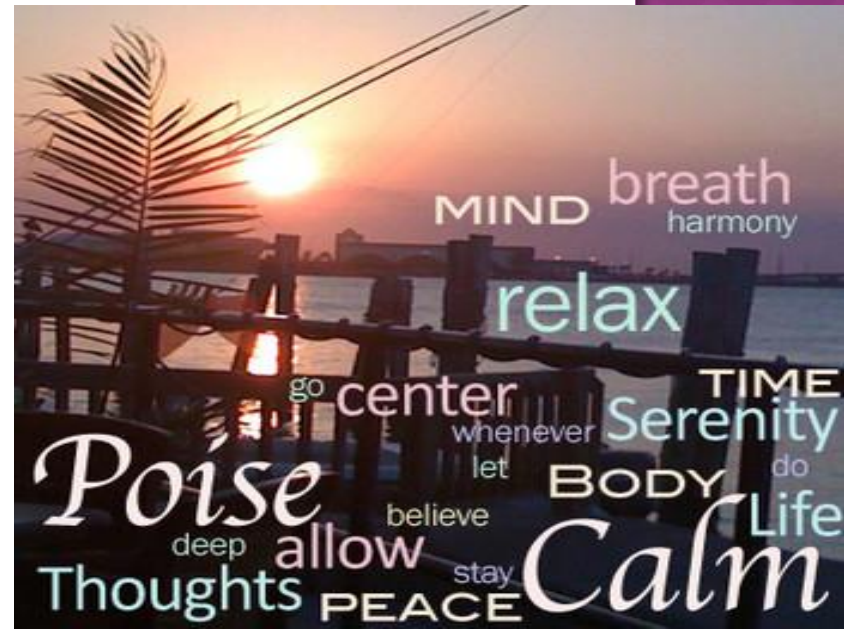
# BALDWIN (BAWL-D-WIN)
