Truth

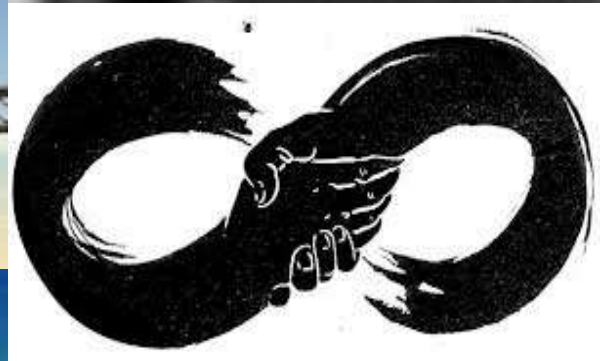
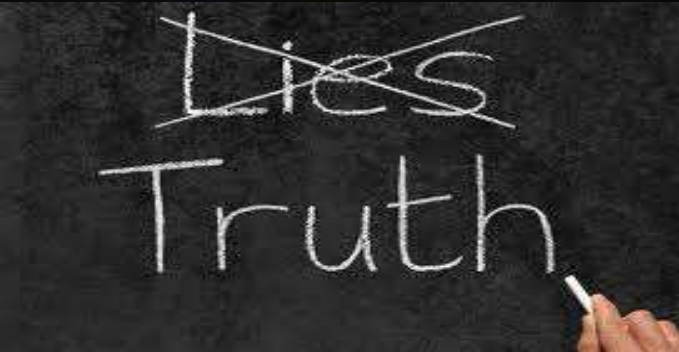
- Pronunciation- (trooth)
