- ◉ In men its ranked 625 while in women its ranked 220.

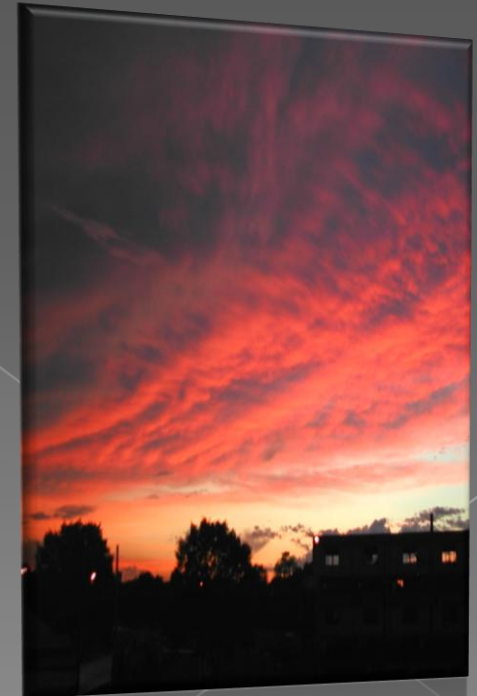


DAWN
