- Music is also vocal, instrumental, or mechanical sounds having rhythm, melody, or harmony.



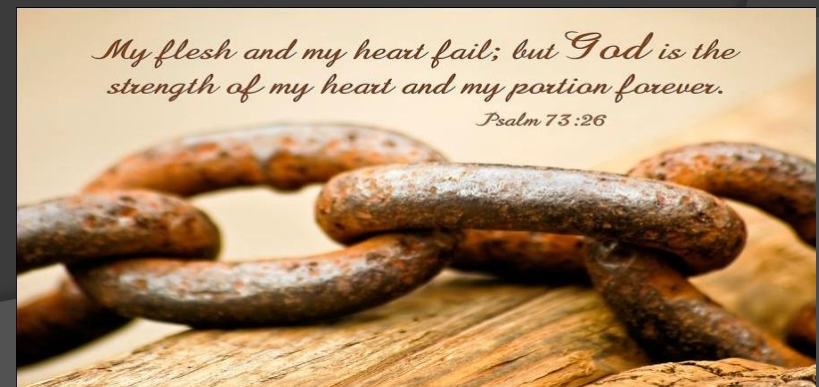
Italy (i-ta-le)
