


Hypotenuse

- Originated in the 1550's from Medieval Latin
- Has been called "al jebr ", meaning reunion of broken parts.
- Definition- the branch of mathematics that deals with general statements of relations.

Chance

- Originated from Old French word cheance during the 1300's
- Meaning-luck, fortune, or the absence of any cause of events that can be predicted, understood, or controlled.
- Originally a pet name for Chauncey
- Ranked number 218 in the United States

Davis

- Originated from the surname David
- David originated from the Hebrew word "Dodaveha"
- The name became popular after the biblical king David of Israel
- The name is ranked #438 in the United States
