

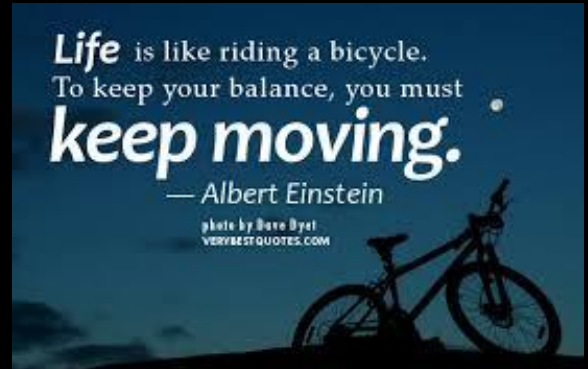

# Inspiration

- **in·spi·ra·tion**
- An inspiring or animating action
- Something inspired, as an idea
- A thing or A person that inspires





# Inspiration

- Something that vexes, a cause of annoyance; nuisance
- Causing frustration
- Origin-1350-1400 middle English *vexacioun*, Latin *vexātiōn*

# Inspiration



- Theology-the divine quality of the writings or words of a person so influenced
- Origin- 1275-1325 middle English *inspiracio*, late Latin *inspīrāt*

# Vexation



- **vex·a·tion**
- The act of vexing
- The state of being vexed

# Vexation



- Something that vexes, a cause of annoyance; nuisance
- Causing frustration
- Origin-1350-1400 middle English *vexacioun*, Latin *vexātiōn*

- **ec·stat·ic**
- of, pertaining to, or characterized by ecstasy
- subject to or in a state of ecstasy; rapturous
- a person subject to fits of ecstasy
- 1620–30;

- Origin- middle French- *extatique*
- Medieval Latin- *ecstaticus*
- Greek- *ekstatikós*
