

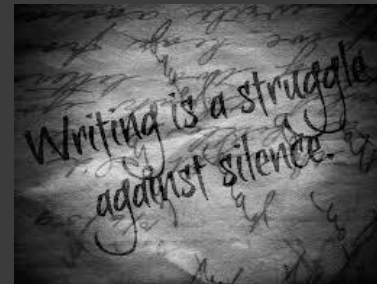

hieroglyphics

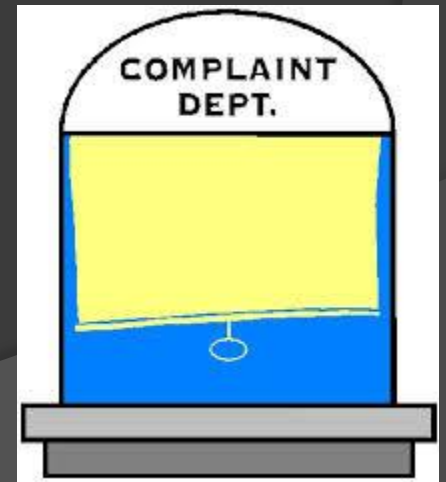


Origin of the word: Writing
