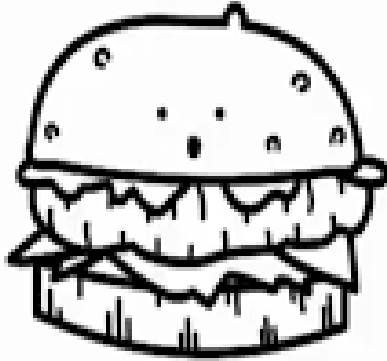

# Samuel

Pronunciation: **sam-yoo-uh** |

Function: *Proper name*

Etymology: Masculine proper name, Biblical judge and prophet, from Late Latin, from Greek *Samouel*, from Hebrew *Shemiel*, meaning Name of God, asked of God, or heard by God.



# Harris



Pronunciation: **har-is**

Function: *Surname*

Etymology: popular surname, designated from 1400s from Harry the popular medieval pronunciation of Henry. In English, the name Harris means - son of Harry. The name Harris originated as an English name. The name Harris is most often used as a male name.

# Buffalo

Pronunciation: **buhf-uh-loh**

Function: *noun*

Definition: a heavily built wild ox with backswept horns, found mainly in the Old World tropics.

the North American bison.

Etymology: 1580s from Portuguese *bufalo* - "water buffalo," from Latin *bufalus*, variant of *bubalus* - "wild ox," from Greek *boubalos* - "buffalo." Wrongly applied since 1630s to the American bison.



# Chair



Pronunciation: Chair

Function: *noun*

Definition: a separate seat for one person, typically with a back and four legs.

Etymology: Early 13<sup>th</sup> Century, *chaere*, from Old French *chaiere* "chair, seat, throne". 12<sup>th</sup> century; Modern French *chaire* "pulpit, throne;" the more modest sense having gone since 16<sup>th</sup> century with variant form *chaise*, from Latin *cathedra* meaning "seat".
