Fish

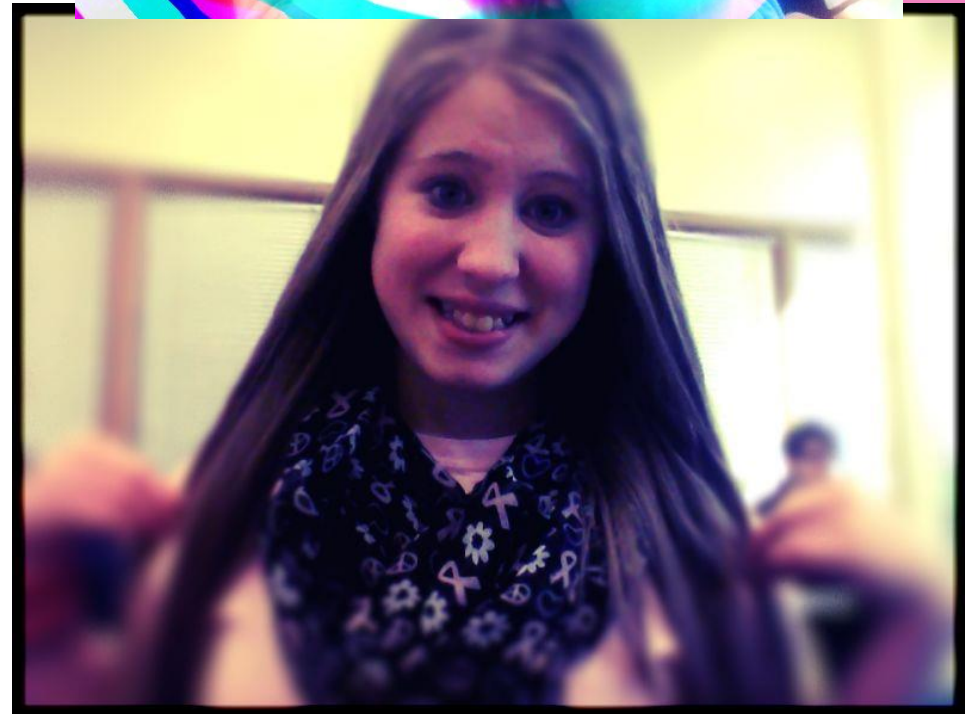
[FiSH]
