- ▶ Pronunciation- huhnt
- ▶ Origin of the word hunt-
- ▶ First ever recorded word hunt being said or when it was made was in the 1570's
- ▶ The word hunt was created many many centuries ago around almost caveman times

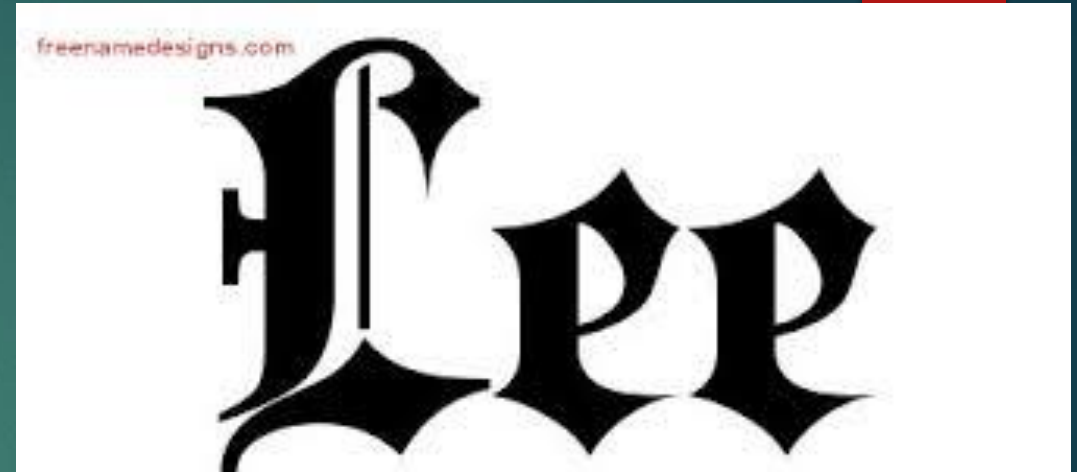

- ▶ GENDER: Masculine & Feminine
- ▶ USAGE: English
- ▶ PRONOUNCED: LEE
- ▶ Meaning in history- From a surname which was derived from Old English leah meaning "clearing". The surname belonged to Robert E. Lee (1807-1870), commander of the Confederate forces during the American Civil War. In his honor, it has been commonly used as a given name in the American South.
- ▶ United States ranked #667
