❖ Adjective

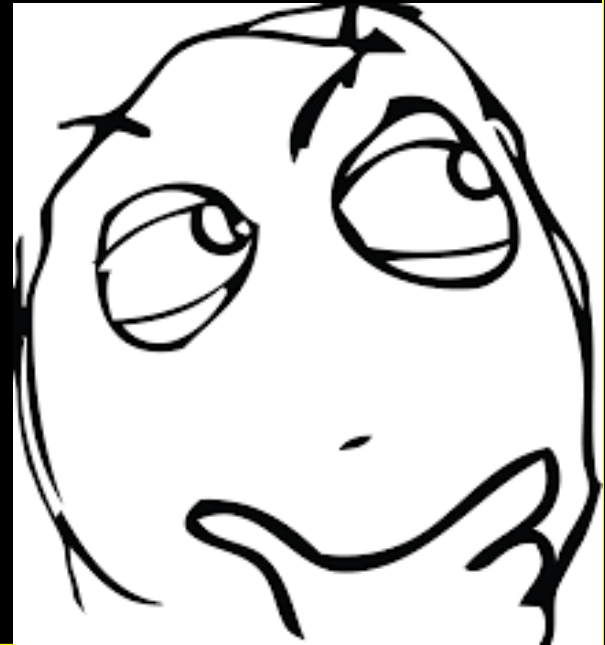
❖ Definition: Calm, Peaceful, or Tranquil; Unruffled
