Swagger, as a verb, means to walk or behave in a very confident way, and typically aggressively

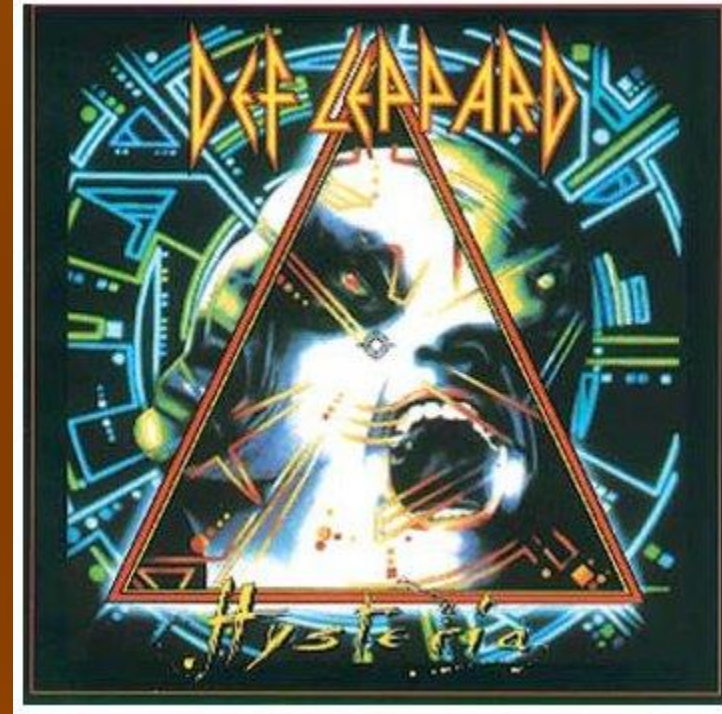


# Armageddon
