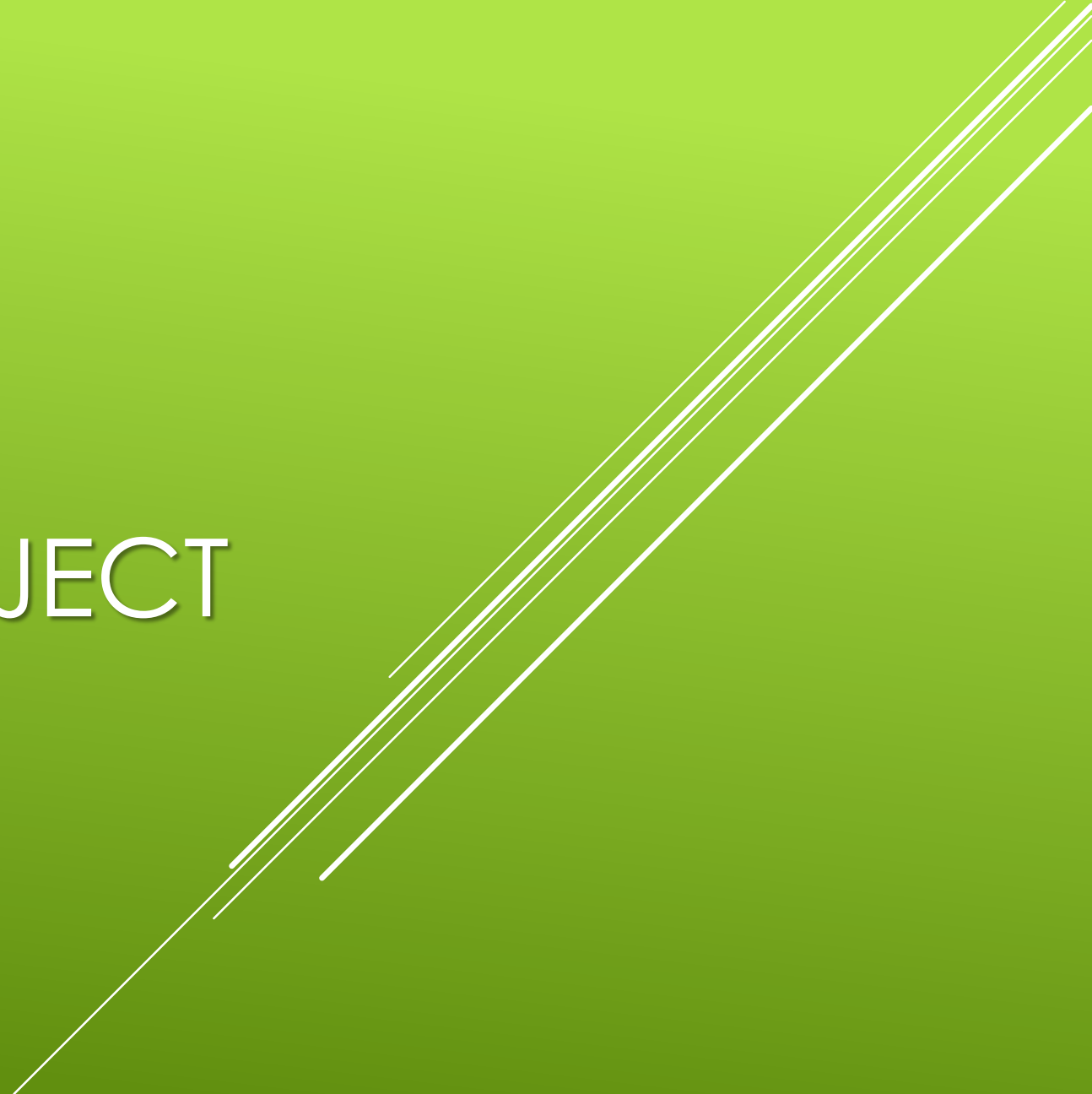

BITE

To cut, tear, wound, grab, or hold with the teeth

Pronunciation [**ba**hyt]

Part of the saying, “bite the bullet” which came from surgeons giving a patient a bullet to bite to distract them from pain during surgery.



PEN



Pronounced – /pen/

An instrument for writing or drawing with ink consisting of a metal nib, ball, or nylon tip connecting to a metal or plastic holder

Originated from the Latin language

The word pen in Greek means: all, every, whole, or all-inclusive

Gender - Male
