strawberry


- ➤ A sweet soft red fruit with a seed –studded surface
- Old English it was streawberige
- ▶ The reason for the name strawberry is uncertain
- Also was called "earth berry"
- ▶ It got its name in 1847



VOLLEYBALL

- a game for two teams, usually of six players, in which a large ball is hit by hand over a high net, the aim being to score points by making the ball reach the ground on the opponent's side of the court.
- ▶ Was established in 1896
- From volley in the sporting sense + ball, so called because the ball must be returned before it hits the ground
