- ▶ A sweet soft red fruit with a seed-studded surface
- ▶ Old English it was streawberige
- ▶ The reason for the name strawberry is uncertain
- ▶ Also was called “earth berry”
- ▶ It got its name in 1847



# VOLLEYBALL

vɒːlibɔːl

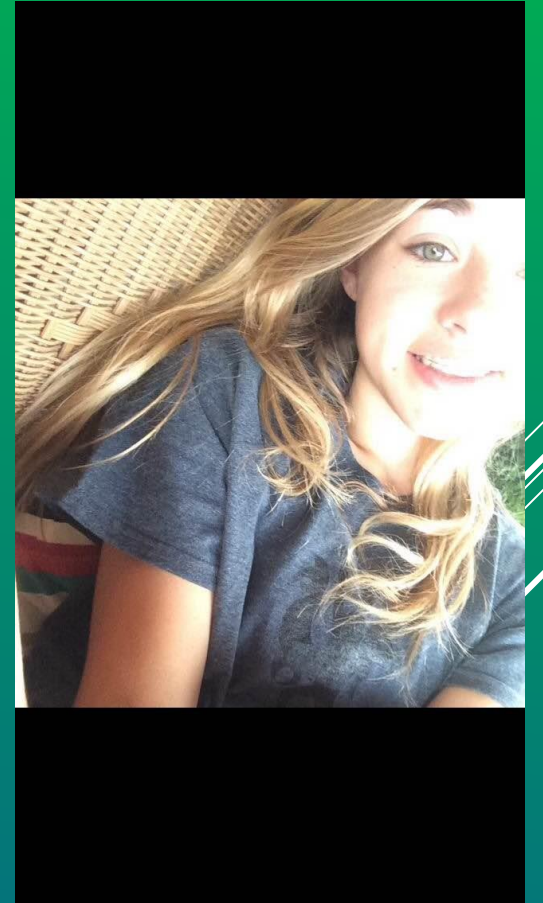
- ▶ a game for two teams, usually of six players, in which a large ball is hit by hand over a high net, the aim being to score points by making the ball reach the ground on the opponent's side of the court.
- ▶ Was established in 1896
- ▶ From volley in the sporting sense + ball, so called because the ball must be returned before it hits the ground



# Taylor

- ▶ From an English surname
- ▶ Which originally denoted to someone who was a tailor
- ▶ Mostly is a Feminine name
- ▶ In the U.S. its ranked #59 for girls
- ▶ In the U.S. its ranked #371 for boys
