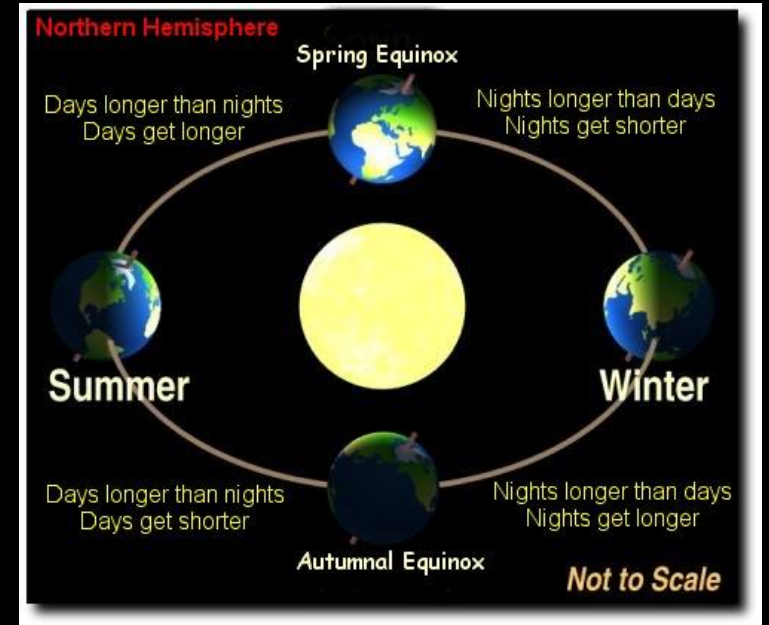

- Came to the English language around century 1400.

Danae -From Δαναοί (Danaoi), a word used by Homer to designate the Greeks. In Greek myth Danaë was a princess of Argos and the mother of Perseus by Zeus, who came to her in the form of a shower of gold. It also means “God is my judge”
