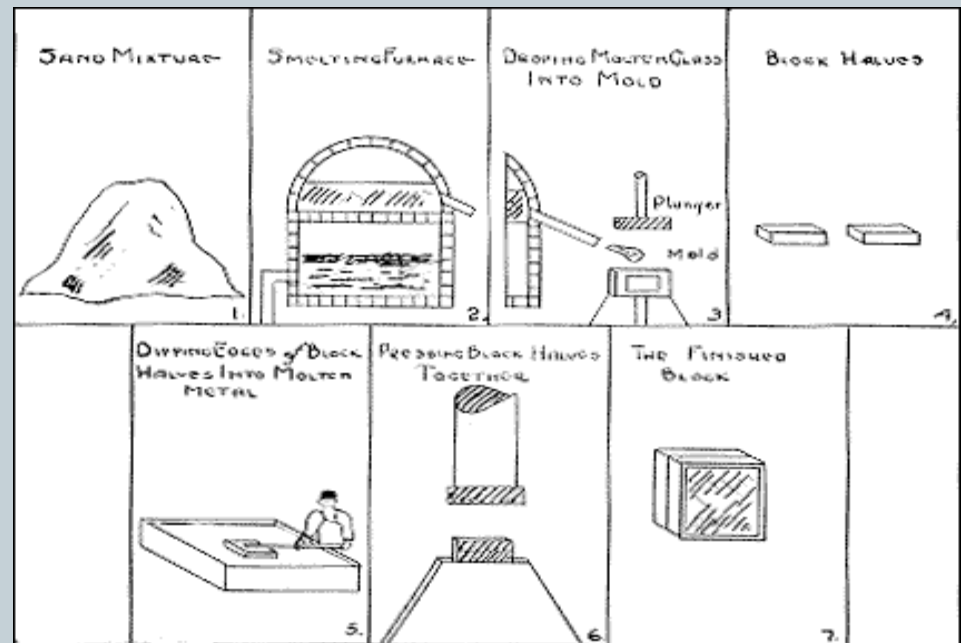
- Hard And Brittle Noncrystalline that is basically transparent. Glass is made by fusion and is commonly used today for Glass bottles and windows.

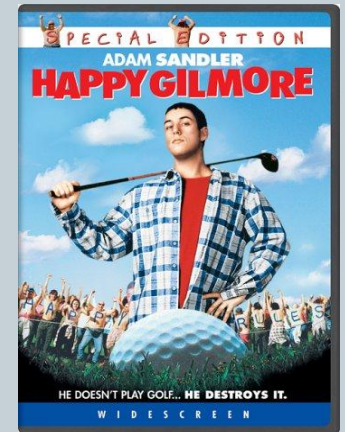
- Window originated in 1200th Century. It comes from Old Norse Vindauga Or Vindr meaning “Wind-Eye.”.
