Jacob

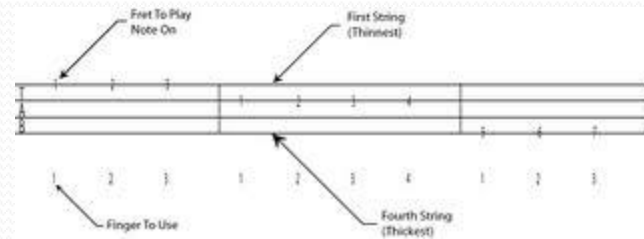
Revenant [rev-uh-nuhnt]

- 1. A person who returns.
- 2. A person who returns as a spirit after death; ghost.
- From French revenant, present participle of revenir "to return"



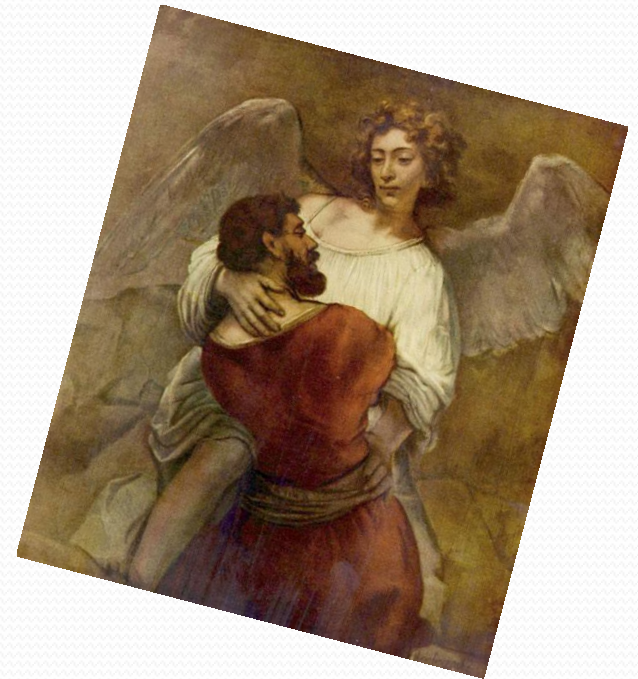
Bassline

- **noun**
- [*music*] The low-pitched instrumental part of a piece of popular music.



Jacob [JAY-kub]

- Origin: Hebrew/Latin
- Meaning: Supplanter; held by the heel
- It is currently the most popular name in the United States and Canada
