## Meaning

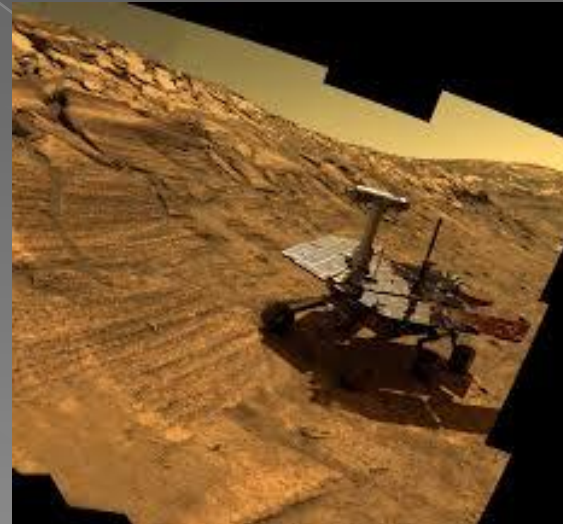
- an appropriate or favorable time or occasion.

Opportunity tends to present itself the more one branches out.

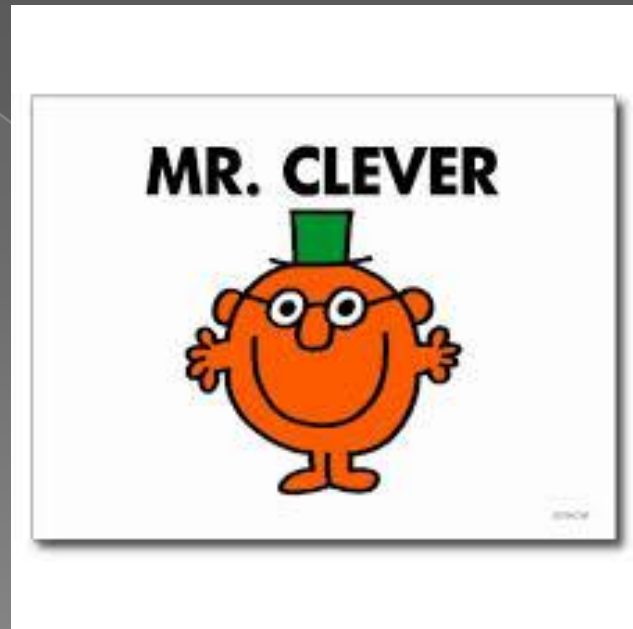
