Art

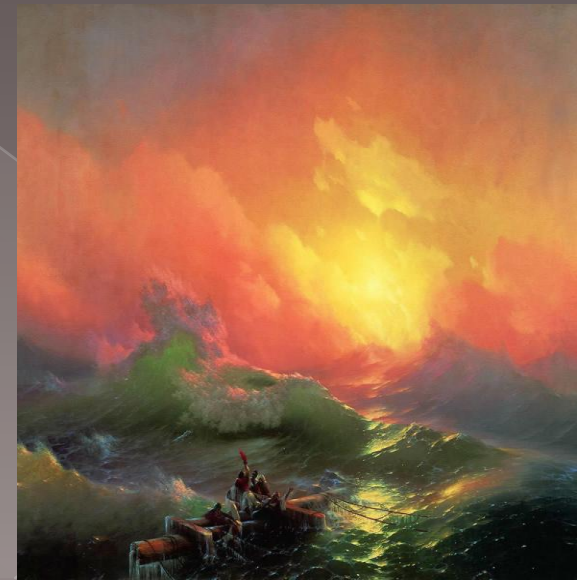


skill as a result of learning or practice
