◎ Definition:

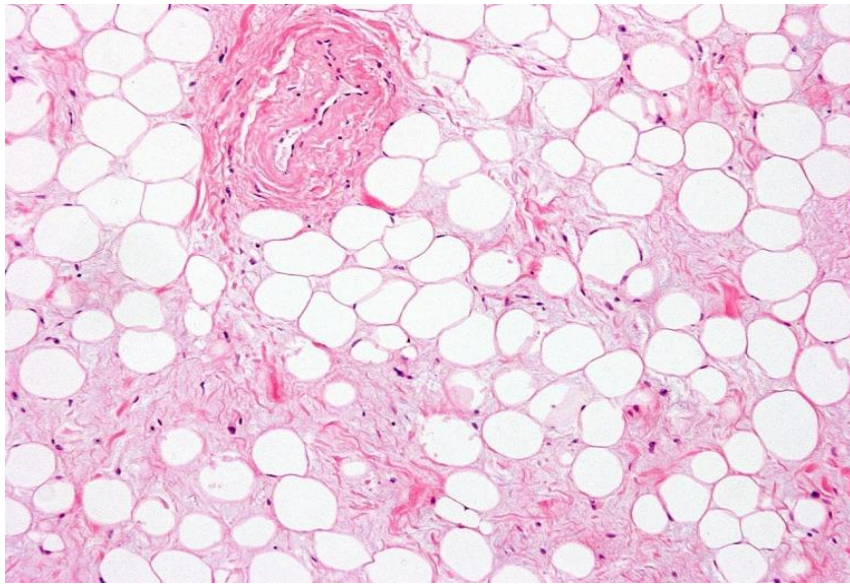
(noun)

1. white or yellowish greasy substances, forming the adipose tissue in animals and also occurring in plants
2. the richest or best part of anything

Origin:

- ◉ Mid-14th century
- ◉ Originated from the Old English word *fættian* which means “to cram, stuff”, from Germanic *fiataz*, from PIE (Proto-Indo-European) *peie* which means “to swell”

Definition:

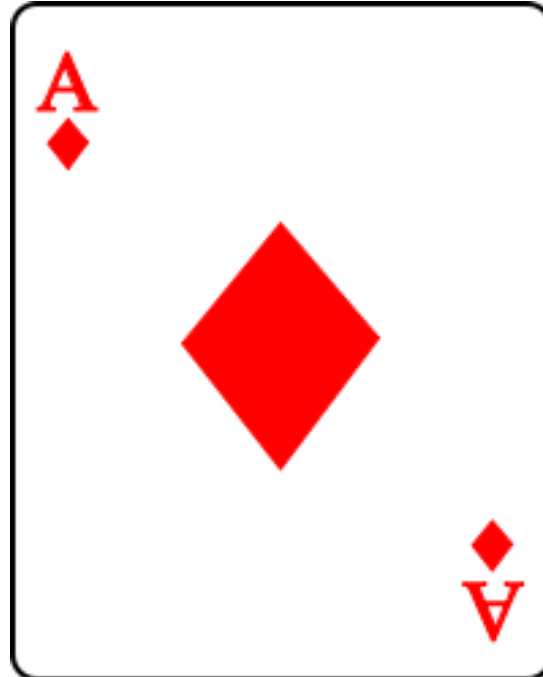
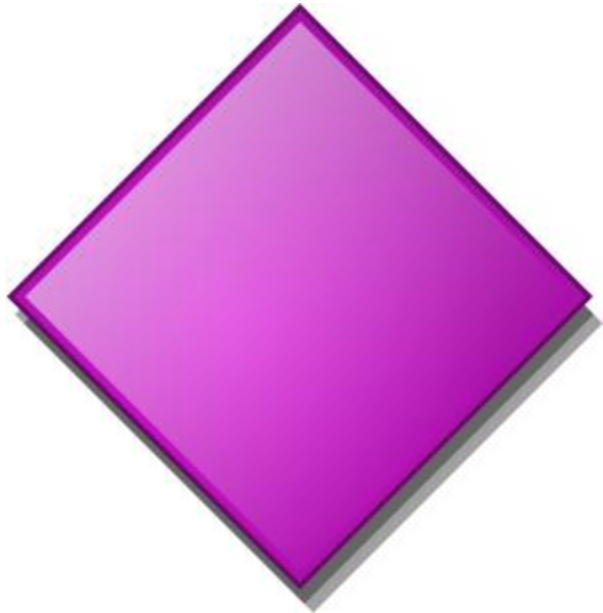
(noun)

3. 4 congruent sided shape with 2 acute angles and 2 obtuse angles
4. baseball field; the figure formed by the bases
5. red-shaped suit symbol on playing cards
