Book

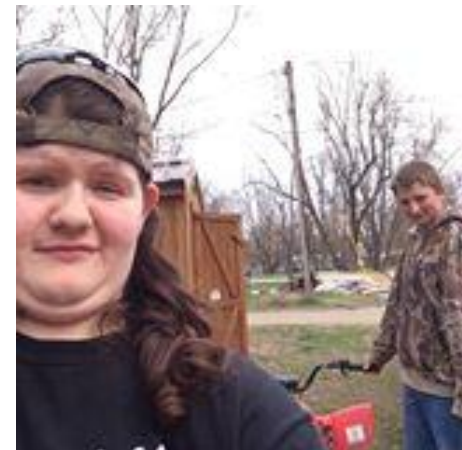
- a handwritten or printed work of fiction or nonfiction, usually on sheets of paper fastened or bound together within covers.
