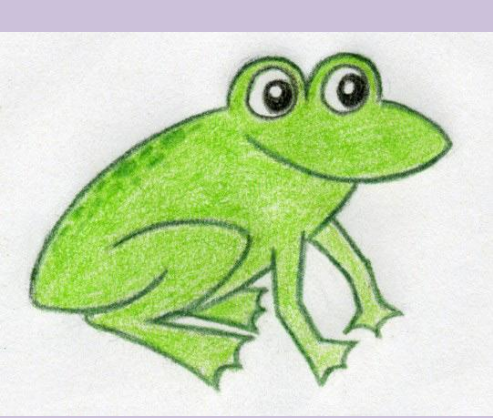

Ranidaphobia

Fear of frogs



- Some believe that frogs are bad omens
- Getting a phobia like this normally occurs after a traumatic experience
- A myth says that if you touch a frog you will have a wart



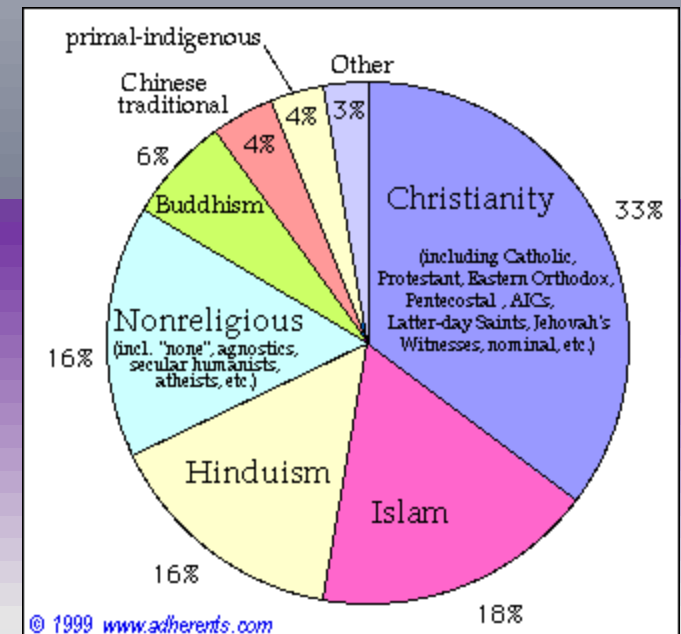
Ranidaphobia (continued)

- The word “rani” (meaning frog) is Latin
- The word “phobia” is Greek
- Related to Batrachphobia (fear of amphibians)
- There are many symptoms of Ranidaphobia such as when you see a frog you have anxiety, short breath, and panting
- Medicine can be prescribed

- First recorded in 1300 but updated in 1530



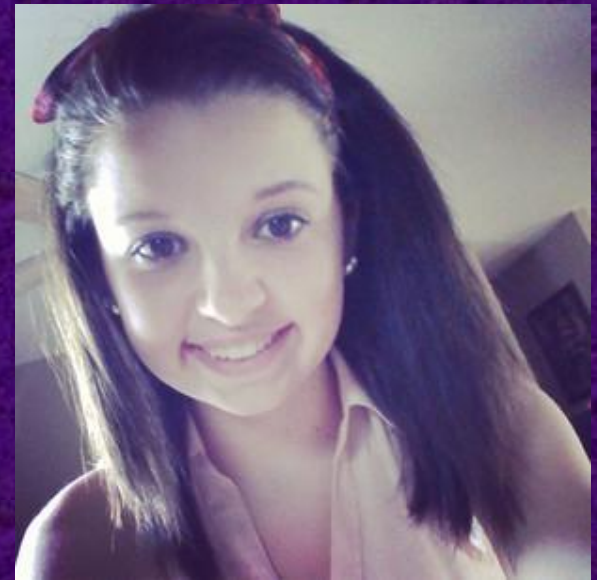
Religion (continued)

- Conduct indicating a belief in a divine power
- An organized collection of belief systems, cultural systems, and world views
- Sometimes used interchangeably with “faith” or “belief system”
- Estimate 4,200 religions in the world

Emilee

- Gender: Feminine
- Usage: English
- Pronounced: EM-ə-lee
- English feminine form of Aemilius
- Wasn't common until German House came to British throne in the 18th century; Princess's name was Amelia. They called her Emilee for short

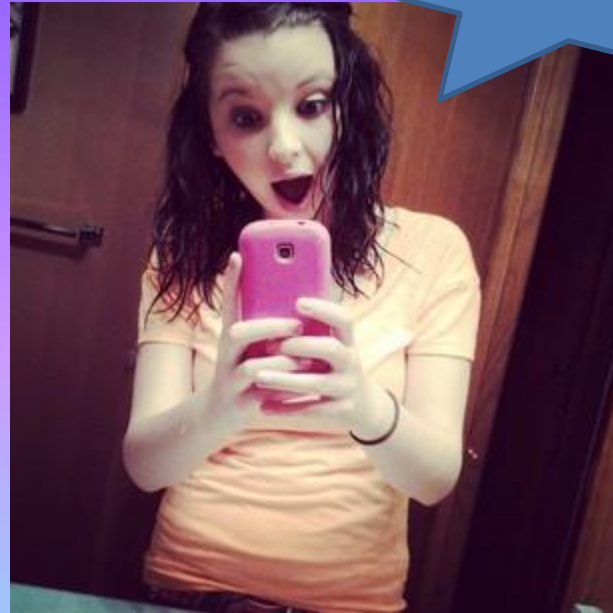
