




## Ranidaphobia

# Ranidaphobia (continued)


- The word "rani" (meaning frog) is Latin
- The word "phobia" is Greek
- Related to Batrachphobia (fear of amphibians)
- There are many symptoms of Ranidaphobia such as when you see a frog you have anxiety, short breath, and panting
- Medicine can be prescribed


