

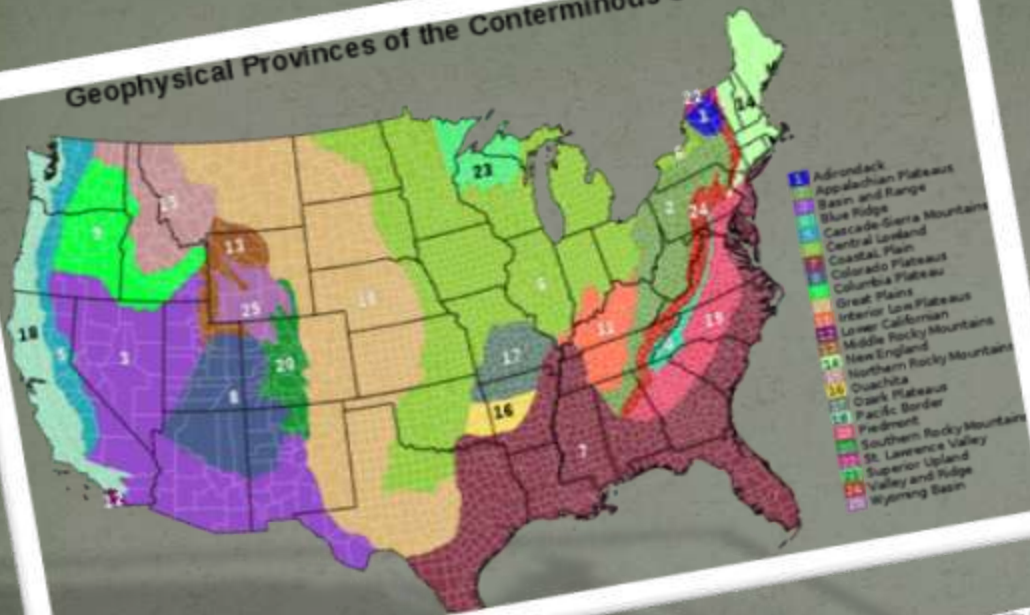

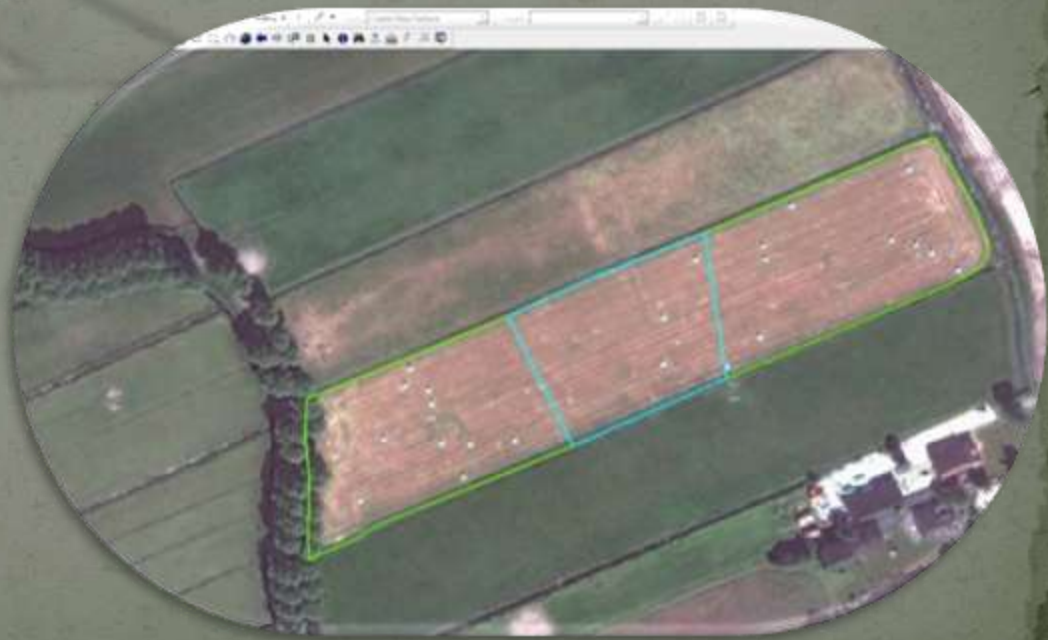
Conterminous

- ❖ (con-ter-min-us)
- ❖ Definitions:
 1. Having a common boundary
 2. Meeting at ends
 3. Covering the same area without an intervening gap
- ❖ Origin – Latin
- ❖ Latin for “bordering upon”

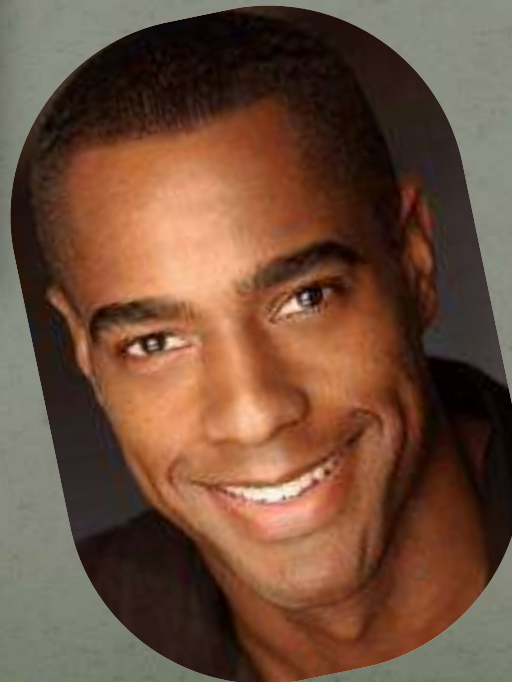
