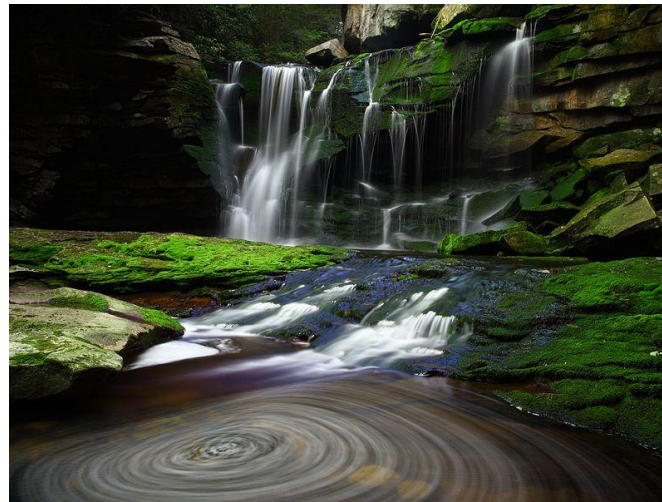
⦿ Pronounced-[pik-cher]
