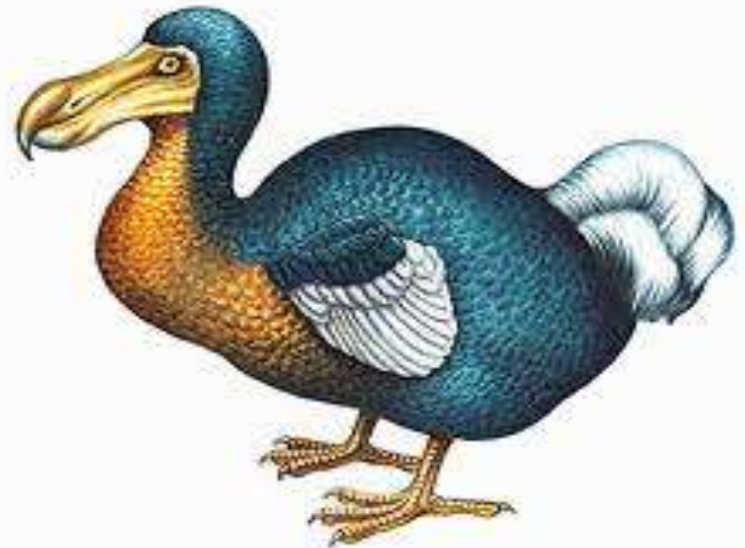

Duke William (1066)A.D defeated the enemy outside his manor and was called Speers after that the name stuck

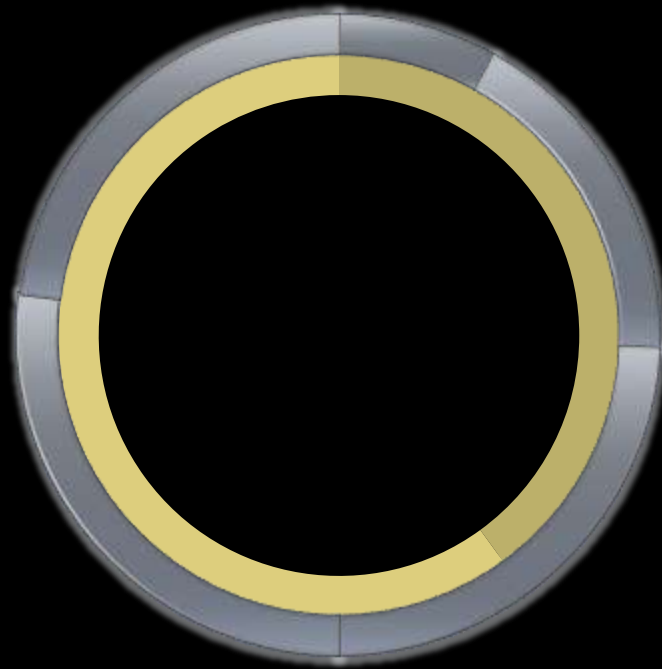
William
