

Etymology

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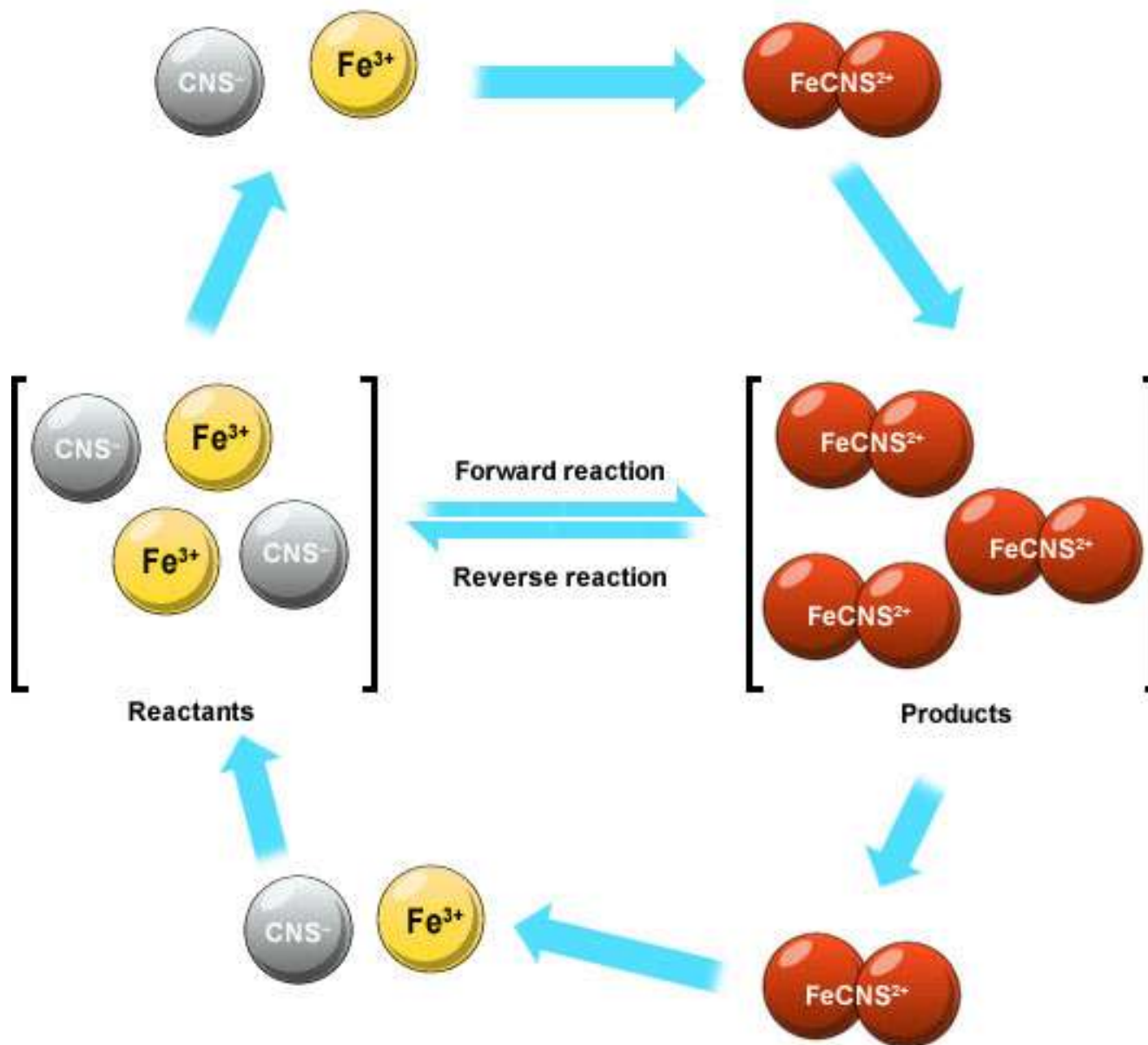
A series of horizontal lines of varying lengths and colors (teal, light blue, white) extending from the right side of the slide.

Equilibrium

- Equilibrium comes from Latin *aequilibrium*
- *Aequus*, meaning equal
- *Libra*, meaning balance, scale, plummet

Definition and Pronunciation

- Equilibrium means to be in a state of rest or balance due to the equal action of opposing forces
- The word equilibrium is pronounced as follows:
- EE-Qua-Lib-Ree-Umm



Zucchini

- Zucchini is of Italian origin
- Plural of zucchini is *zucchini*, diminutive of *zucca*, meaning gourd or squash
- Also from Late Latin *cucitia*, of unknown origin

Definition and Pronunciation

- Zucchini is a green variety of smooth-skinned summer squash
- The Pronunciation of the word zucchini is as follows:
- Zoo-Key-Knee



Denzil

- Denzil is of Celtic origin
- Means fertile land, fort
- Derived from a Cornish surname with German roots
- Name was originally given to someone living in Denzell in Cornwall, England
- Denzil is a fairly unpopular name
